



RIDE SAFE



Create a safe and friendly
Off Road Vehicle (ORV) environment
by adhering to the following rules:

Ontario Highway Traffic Act; Off Road Vehicles Act

- You **MUST** be 16 years of age **AND** hold the minimum of a valid class G2 driver's license to operate an ORV.
- You **MUST** wear a helmet when operating an ORV.
- You **MUST** have valid insurance and registration for your ORV.
- **NO PASSENGERS**—even with an approved passenger seat.
- When riding in a 50 km speed limit zone you may travel on the shoulder of the road at a speed not to exceed 20 km/hr.

The City of Kenora By-law #166-2015

For all types of ORV, travel within the City of Kenora is
RESTRICTED in the following areas:

- All sidewalks
- All recreational trails owned by the City of Kenora
- Parks and beaches owned or operated by the City of Kenora
- Lake of the Woods Cemetery
- All municipal property

No racing of ORV unless approved by the Council of the City of Kenora.

Park in designated areas only

Respect private property

SAFE SNOWMOBILING

Kenora is a Snowmobile Friendly Community
Ride with care and respect the law by adhering
to the following rules:

The City of Kenora By-law #141-2011 as amended

Speed Limits

The speed limit for a snowmobile within the City boundary is 20 km/hr. **There is a \$110.00 fine for exceeding this limit.**

Restricted Areas

The Cemetery, Safety Bay and the Harbourtown Centre being North of Laurenson's Creek and South of the CP Railway tracks are restricted areas in the City. **There is an \$80.00 fine for this offence.**

Racing of Snowmobiles

City of Kenora prohibits the racing of snowmobiles unless approved by the Council of the City of Kenora. **There is a \$260.00 fine for this offence.**

Sidewalks

No snowmobiling on sidewalks. **There is an \$80.00 fine for this offence.**



Restriction by Time

You cannot operate a snowmobile between the hours of 11:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m. as per schedule "D" of by-law #141-2011 as amended. **There is an \$80.00 fine for this offence.**

Drivers Under 16

If you are between the age of 12 and 15 and hold a Snow Vehicles Operator's License, you may operate a snowmobile; however, **it is illegal to drive on or drive across any road.**
